



COVID-19 Emergency Licensing for Internationally Trained Healthcare Workers

New York State Portal and Application Process

*On March 23, 2020, Governor Cuomo issued an emergency order that provides increased flexibility for internationally trained doctors already in residency programs. **Executive Order 202.10** reduces (from three years to one year) the residency requirement threshold for graduates of international medical schools.*

Eligibility

Pursuant to E.O. **202.10**, graduates of foreign medical schools with at least one year of graduate medical education in the U.S. are allowed to apply for a **limited permit** in order to join the fight against COVID-19 and provide patient care in hospitals.
